Eligibility	The course is open to post-graduates (MA/MSc/MTech/MLIS or equivalent in any discipline with 55% or above; SC/ST/PD 50% or above). Students who have finished their final examinations and are awaiting results may also apply, provided that they have the requisite marks in previous components/semesters. Familiarity with basic computer operations essential
Duration	2 semesters (July-December, January- May)
Tentative date of commencement of classes	29 July, 2013
Course fee	Rs 3000 per semester (Rs 6000 for entire course)
Submission of Applications	From 15 th June to 12 th July, 2013 (both days inclusive) Application forms should be downloaded from the University website and to be submitted either in person or through a messenger, at the office of the School of Cultural Texts and Records, Jadavpur University, along with a Demand Draft of Rs 50 drawn in favour of Jadavpur University, as application fee. All application forms must be properly filled in. Incomplete forms will be rejected.
Date of written examination and interview	17 July 2013
Intake	25 (Reservations for ST/SC/PH and others will be made as per University rules).
